Proposal: Tacoma Water has prepared our 2018 Water System Plan to bring together our

planning efforts for the next 10 years looking at supply, demand, infrastructure, operations, maintenance, and financial capability to comply with relevant local, state and federal plans and regulations. This plan required by the Department of Health demonstrates how the system will address present and future needs in a manner consistent with other relevant plans and local, state, and federal

laws, including applicable land use plans.

Location: Tacoma Water provides direct retail water service to customers in the City of

Tacoma, City of University Place, town of Ruston, and portions of Fircrest, Lakewood, Puyallup, Bonney Lake, Federal Way, Pierce County and King County; wholesale water service to other water systems; is a Regional Water Supply System partner; and approved satellite system management agency.

Appeals may be filed at the Superior Court of the State of Washington for Pierce County within 21 days after the final determination. Appeals to the Superior Court shall be taken in accordance with procedures and limitations set forth in RCW 43.21C.075. A copy of the appeal shall be filed with Building and Land Use Services, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington 98402.
