The current version of the Comprehensive Plan is also called the "One Tacoma Plan." The Utilities Element of the older version of the Comprehensive Plan has been replaced with the "Public Facilities and Services Element." Please visit www.cityoftacoma.org/OneTacoma for more details.
- 2. In Table 2-3, concerning "Annexation Policy", please consider adding "One Tacoma Comprehensive Plan, Public Facilities and Services Element" as an additional source. Please review annexation related policies contained in the element, i.e., Goal PFS-2 and Policies PFS-2.1 through PFS-2.7 (on pages 9-7, 9-8 and 9-9), and cite appropriate policies.
- 3. In Table 2-3, concerning "Surcharge for Outside Customers", the reference to the Comprehensive Plan's Utilities Element should be replaced with "One Tacoma Comprehensive Plan, Public Facilities and Services Element." As to the appropriate policies to cite, please see Note #2 above.
- 4. In Table 2-3, concerning "Urban Growth Areas", the reference to the Comprehensive Plan's Utilities Element should be replaced with "One Tacoma Comprehensive Plan, Public Facilities and Services Element." As to the appropriate policies to cite, please see Note #2 above and please review level of service standard related policies contained in the element, i.e., Goal PFS-4 and Policies PFS-4.1 through PFS-4.10 (on pages 9-10, 9-11, 9-12 and 9-13).
- 5. Concerning the "2017-2022 Capital Facilities Program" that appears in the Executive Summary (page xvi) and in Section 11.3 (page 11-9), please be advised that the document is being updated to "2019-2024 Capital Facilities Program" by the Finance Department's Office of Management and Budget.
