Fun for one...

Planning to camp on your own or in a small group? Reserve individual campsites in one of four areas at Mossyrock Park: Main Campground, Cascade Loop, Bird's Eye View or S'mores Loop. Choose a site with or without hookups, or aim for adventure and reserve one of the 12 walk-in tent sites.

...and fun for all

Group campers who seek a rustic environment might enjoy one of the primitive group camp areas. Both areas include 12 sites with picnic tables, fire rings and water. Primitive Group Camp 1 offers a vault toilet for a back-to-the-basics experience for campers. Primitive Group Camp 2 sits near a restroom with showers.

Take a hike

You and your family can get a little closer to nature by hiking on the two trails that begin near the Primitive Group Camp 1 area. In the summer, be on the lookout for birds, squirrels, chipmunks and raccoons. Winter campers may get an eyeful of elk. Herds of up to 80 have been known to wander through the park between November and March.

Dam tall

Just a short drive away, you'll find an engineering marvel, Mossyrock Dam. It is the tallest dam in Washington state, standing 606 feet above bedrock. Not only does it look impressive, it also generates about one billion kilowatt-hours of electricity each year, enough to power about 78,000 Northwest homes.

Riffe Lake levels

To protect public safety, Tacoma Power will hold Riffe Lake's elevation down approximately 30 feet lower than full (778 ft.) at least into the next decade. Learn more at MyTPU.org/RiffeLake. Get lake level and boat launch info at MyTPU.org/LakeLevels or call 888-502-8690.

Directions

From Tacoma, take I-5 South to Highway 12 East (Exit 68). Drive approximately 21 miles and turn right on Williams Street. Continue several blocks to a "T" intersection in the town of Mossyrock. Turn left onto State Street. State Street becomes Mossyrock Road East, and then Ajlune Road, which leads to the park.

- Group camps (open May 15 -Sept. 15)

- Coin-operated showers
- Laundry facilities
- Wheelchair-accessible sites, restrooms, and a trail
- Reservable kitchen shelter
- Disc golf course
- Off-leash dog park
