FTC Decision and Justification

The Cowlitz Fisheries Technical Committee (FTC) agrees for Tacoma Power to proceed with construction of the Cowlitz Falls North Shore Collector (CFNSC) facility, based upon a final approval of the 100% design documents.

Proposed Decision or Consideration

Obtain FTC approval of the 100% design documents after satisfactorily addressing any questions and comments from the FTC review process.

Background

The FTC reviewed the 30%, then 60% and then 90% CFNSC design documents and Design Basis Memorandum in 2014. Questions and comments were entered into a comment spreadsheet where responses were included. All comments and responses were posted on the FTC password-protected website. The same approval process was applied to all of the various design packages.

The 100% Design Package is scheduled to be submitted to the FERC and put out for bid in December of 2014. Construction is likely to begin in early March of 2015.
