TERMS & CONDITIONS

Approval and payment of Rebate, or Standard, Forgivable or Deferred Loan (Loan) is conditioned upon and subject to the following Terms & Conditions. Documents or websites referred to in this Application are a part of and incorporated into this Application.

ELIGIBILITY: Property must be served by a Tacoma Power residential account. Energy-efficient products (Products) included in this offer must meet and be installed to Tacoma Power's Program Specifications and meet Program Requirements, found at MyTPU.org/ Incentives.

REBATE AND LOAN INCENTIVES: Limits apply and are based on all specified Products installed and will not exceed total installed conservation improvement costs minus manufacturer/dealer rebates. This Program may be modified or canceled at any time and is subject to availability of funds.

STANDARD, FORGIVABLE or DEFERRED LOAN: Loan may be available to qualified customers to help pay for installation of Products. Before work begins, the loan must be pre-approved by Tacoma Power and a Notice to Proceed issued. Qualified knob and tube wiring inspection will be paid for by Tacoma Power. Standard Loans require equal monthly payments for duration of loan term. Forgivable Loans are forgiven only after all the affordability terms are met. Deferred Loan payment is deferred until the Property is no longer owner-occupied.

DO-IT-YOURSELF (DIY) PROJECTS: A product installed by the Owner or by a contractor that is not a Tacoma Power Participating Contractor does not qualify for a rebate, or loan incentive. Rebate, or loan will be deducted from the invoice by Tacoma Power Participating Contractor.

Any authorization for Tacoma Power to pay any amount to the Tacoma Power Participating Contractor by assignment of funds is not intended and shall not be construed or deemed to establish any express or implied contractual relationship whatsoever between Tacoma Power and the Contractor(s). Tacoma Power's sole obligations are to provide the financial arrangements and Rebate, and Loan described in this form and approve installations for compliance with Tacoma Power Program Specifications and Program Requirements.
