A water utility worker performs semi-skilled manual labor assisting in the installation, maintenance, and repair of water supply and distribution facilities and systems. The role also involves operating a variety of equipment and machinery, performing frequent heavy lifting, and working outdoors in all types of weather conditions.

Duties include installing, maintaining, and repairing:

- Pipes
- Meter yokes
- Meters
- Meter boxes
- Gate valves
- Fire hydrants
- Concrete vaults
- Other water system components

Our apprenticeships are craft-based, high intensity learning and instruction, using a combination of classroom and on-the-job training.
