

Making the most of the calm before storms

How our summer prep supports year-round reliability

Every summer, our crews take advantage of dry weather to prepare for storm season, helping us enter fall and winter ready to keep your power reliable.

We inspect and replace poles, trim trees near lines, and clear overgrowth to lower outage risks and guard against wildfires. Within substations, we test and upgrade equipment, such as transformers and circuit breakers, to reduce failures and speed up restoration. We also use drones for aerial inspections to catch potential issues early and make repairs before severe weather hits.

If you see our crews in your neighborhood, please slow down, follow all posted signs, and give them the space they need to work safely. U*

Protect your digital footprint from Al-powered cyberattacks

Artificial Intelligence (AI) can be a helpful tool, but it can also make online and phone-based utility scams even more sophisticated. Scammers are now using AI to create targeted phishing campaigns with realistic audio and video to bypass identity verification and spread misinformation.

Some ways to keep your digital information safe:

- Don't reuse passwords between different websites.
- Use complex passwords, also known as "passphrases," to make them more difficult to crack.
- Never click on suspicious links in emails or text messages.
- Call us to verify unexpected emails or text messages you may receive.

We take cybersecurity seriously. We will never:

- Call, email, make a home visit demanding immediate payment, or requesting credit card, banking, or financial information.
- Request payment on a prepaid card.
- Shut off service without providing written notice at least seven days in advance.
