

Protecting Tacoma's Drinking Water

The South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District (STGPD) helps protect the underground aquifer that supplies up to half of our water during the warmer months.

The Tacoma City Council recently updated the STGPD code to strengthen protections:

Safer land uses: New rules for certain businesses to help keep groundwater clean.

Stronger enforcement: Faster response and better coordination across agencies to resolve violations quickly.

Greener design: Better stormwater infiltration and landscaping standards that helps cool areas and reduce paved surfaces.

Expanded protection: Updated maps include Wellhead Protection Areas and the Manitou neighborhood.
