 - Projects

 - Grid mod funding
 - Grant opportunities
 - Utility no-cost Allowances



- Power
 - No cost allowance adjustment mechanism
 - Solar policy
- Water
 - Upper Green River watershed acquisition
- Rail
 - Tax credit bill
- TPU-Wide
 - Statewide low-income benefits
 - Dig law
