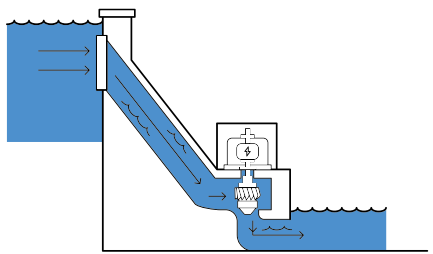
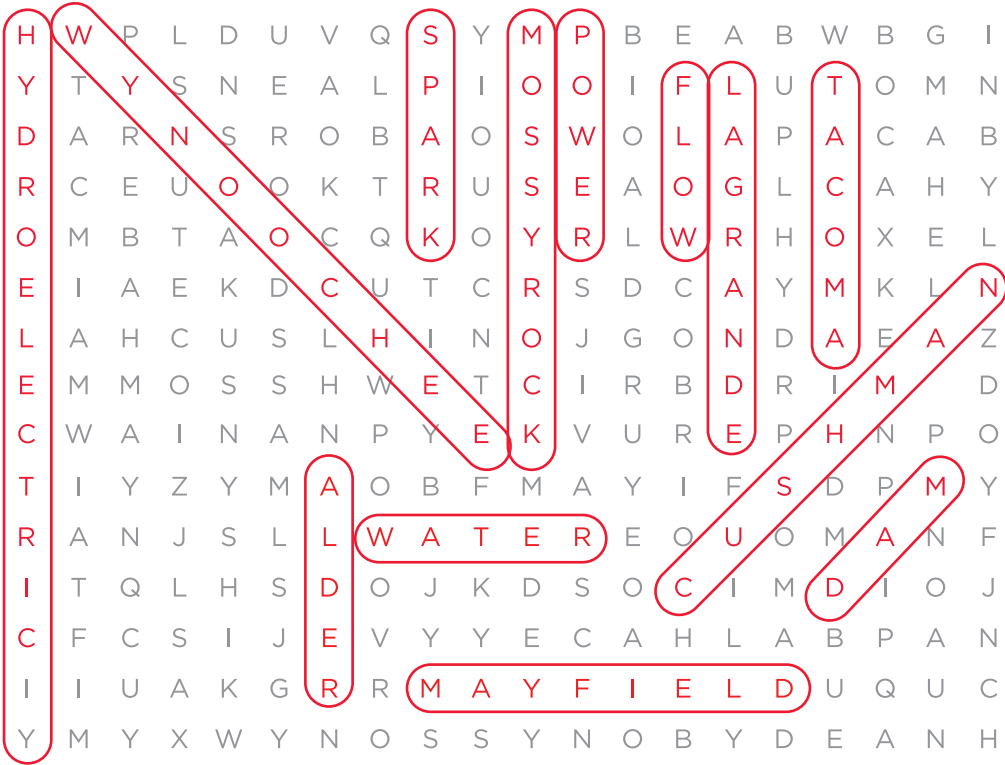
Spark lives at Tacoma Power's six hydroelectric dams and loves teaching others about electricity.

Join Spark on an adventure to discover how power is created at the dams and delivered to homes, schools, and businesses throughout our community.



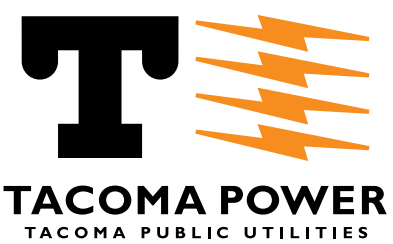

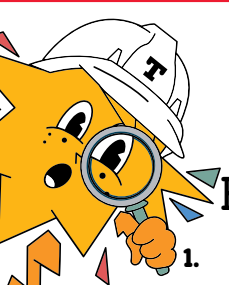

Tacoma Power makes most of its electricity from moving water. This is called hydropower. It is a clean, renewable energy source!

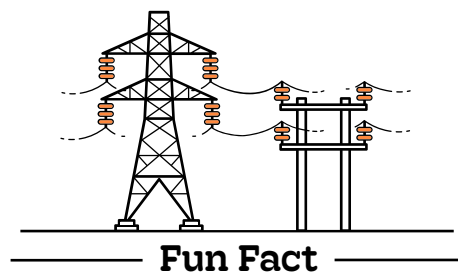
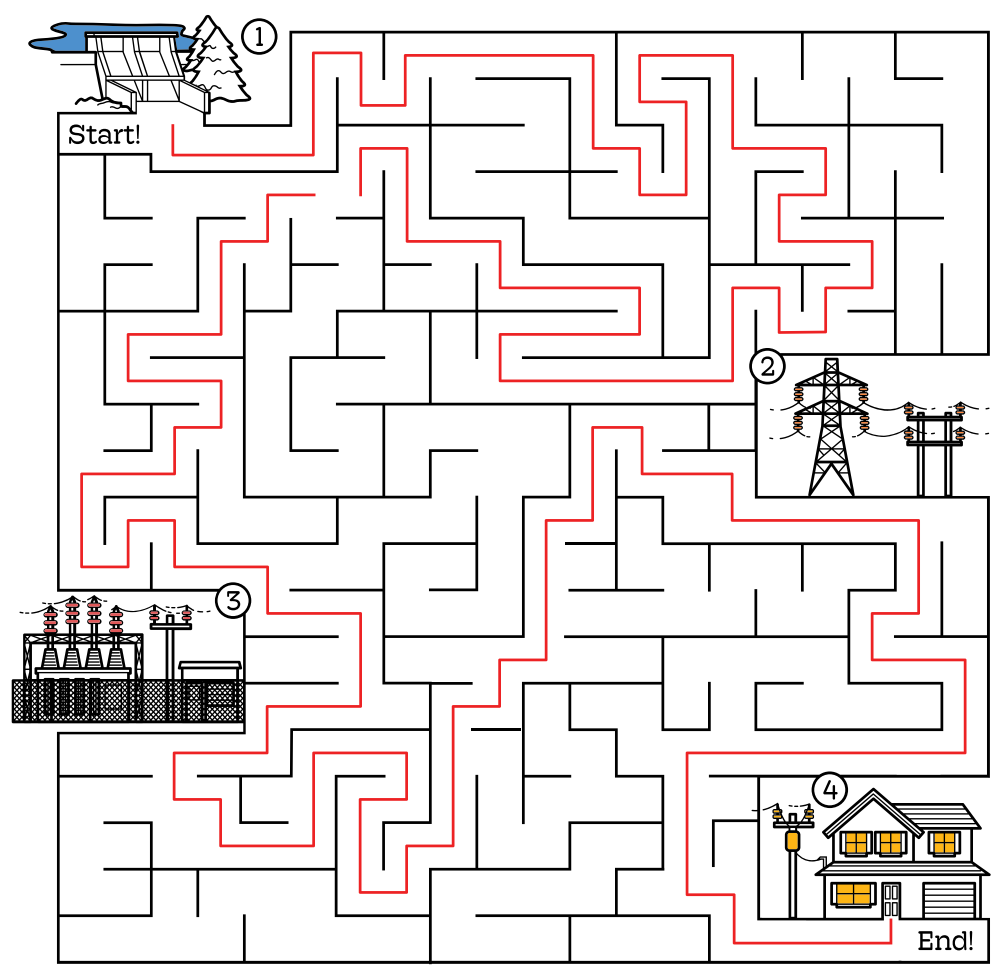




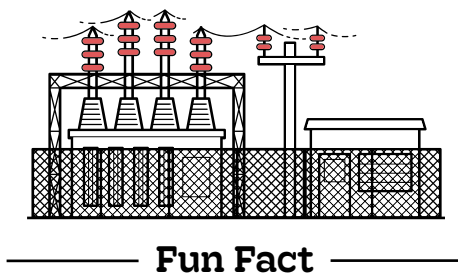
Traveling on High Voltage Lines to the Substation

Help Spark find their way from the dam to your home.

1. Start at the dam.
2. Be sure to pass by the Transmission and Distribution Power Lines and,
3. the Substation on the way
4. home.



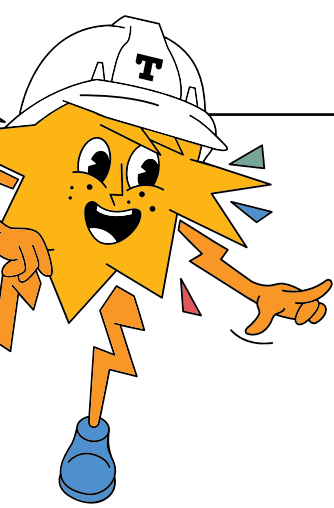
High voltage lines carry electricity long distances. Never go near power lines. You can get hurt even if you do not touch them!



Substations are inside fenced yards because of extremely high power voltages. Tacoma Power distributes the power to a lower voltage line to be sent to homes, schools, and businesses.

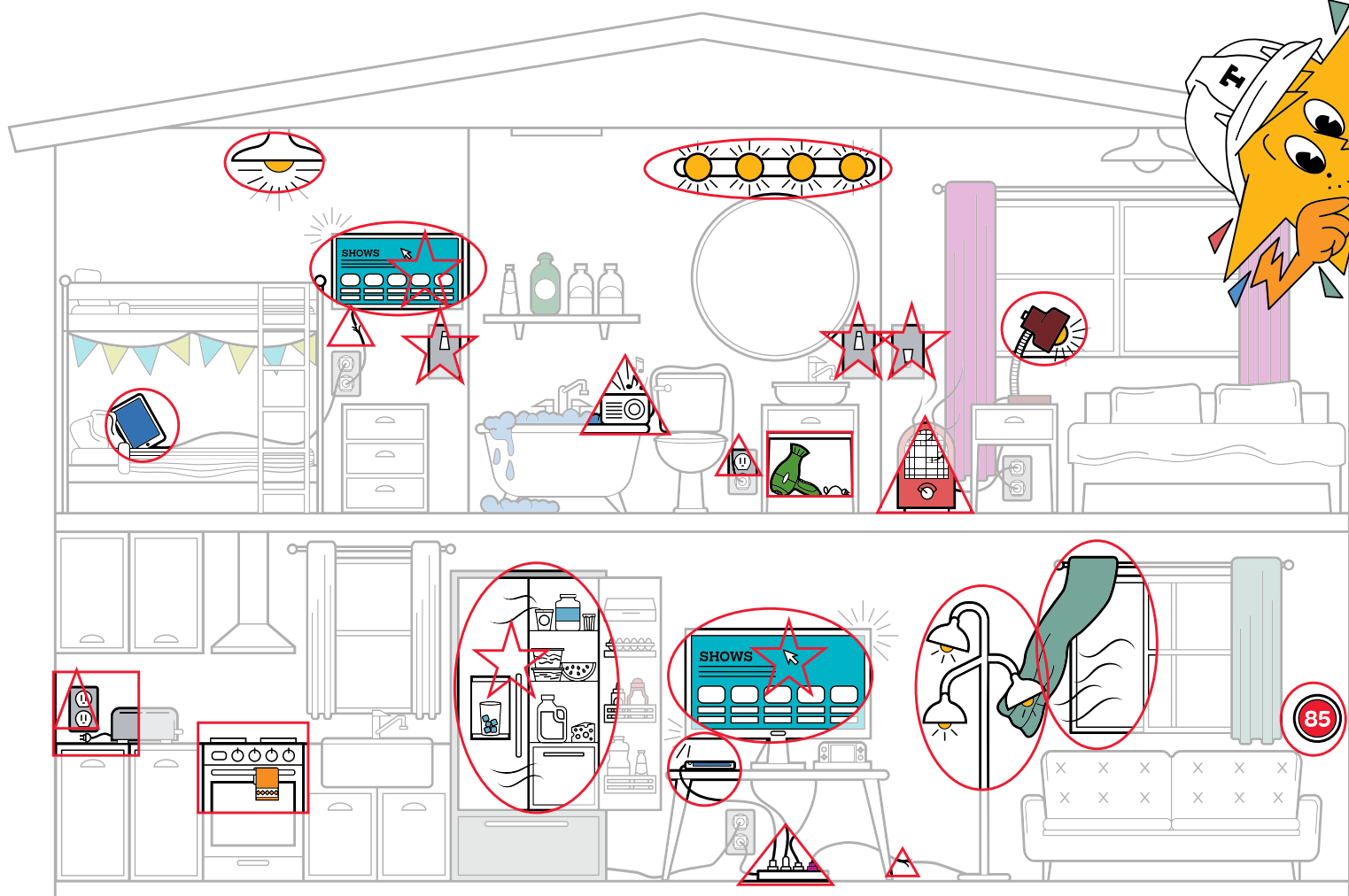

- ☐ Thermostat set too high or too low.

- ☐ Light switch
- ☐ TV's
- ☐ Open fridge

Place a triangle ▲ around the unsafe hazards.

- ☐ Overloaded outlets with too many plugs
- ☐ Damaged cords (frayed, cracked, chewed, or tape wrapped)
- ☐ Outlets without safety covers
- ☐ Space heaters too close to curtains
- ☐ Cords near water

Place a square □ around the safe items.

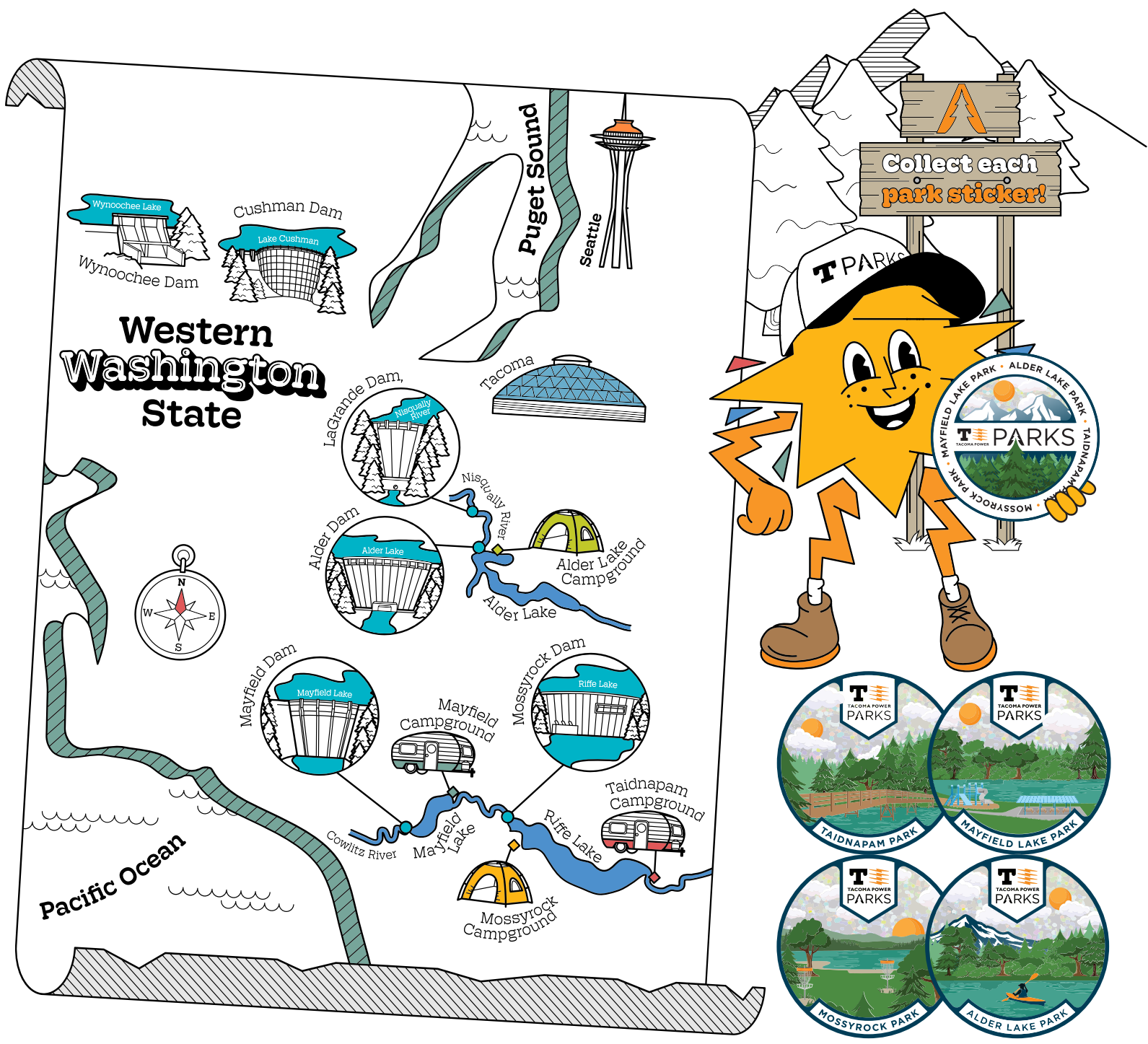
