- **SAP Now!** is a multi-year program to plan and execute this migration including efficiency enhancements for selected business processes.





SAP by the Numbers

- 570,609 tables
- 42 distinct integrated business functions
- 156 interfaces to 90 other applications
- Over 1000 data assets from Hanalytics
- 2,419 transactions executed 88,174,054 times in the last year
- 1.25 million lines of custom code
- Unlimited number of department specific use cases

Projected Expenditures

The SAP Now! Program was approved to move forward during 2023, with the understanding that the projects would continue through the 2025-2026 biennium.

\$6.2 M Approved for 2024 in Mid Mod

• City Council approved \$6.2M for SAP Now! for 2024 during the Mid Modification.





\$17 M Estimated for 2025-26 The Program is estimating licensing and project implementation costs of approximately \$17M in 2025-2026. This does not include direct labor costs for city employees.
