Program Overview

 \$150 million of CCA funds for one-time, \$200 bill credits to low- and moderate-income customers to "help with the clean energy transition"

- \$7.4 million for TPU (draft amount)
 - \$7 million for households
 - Up to \$370,000 for admin expenses
 - Approx. 35,000 37,000 households served
- Eligibility is determined by income
 - Priority: 80 percent area median income (AMI)
 - Customers eligible up to 150 percent AMI
