6 WHEREAS the proposed LOA covers the voluntary recognition of a  
7 classification to be titled Engineering Instrumentation Technician, Senior (CSC  
8 2020), and

9 WHEREAS the proposed LOA establishes the rates of pay for the  
10 classification for the purposes of collective bargaining, and

11 WHEREAS the proposed classification in the LOA will be designated as  
12 hourly, and eligible for overtime pay, and

13 WHEREAS it now appears in the best interest of the City that the  
14 proposed LOA negotiated by the Union and the City be approved; Now,

15 Therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUBLIC UTILITY BOARD OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

17 That it is in the best interest of the City that the proposed Letter of  
18 Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Professional &  
19 Technical Employees Union, Local 17, be approved, and the Council of the City  
20 of Tacoma is requested to concur in the approval, pass an implementing pay  
21 and compensation ordinance, and authorize the proper officers of the City to  
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execute said Letter of Agreement substantially in the form on file, as approved

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by the City Attorney.
