You have expressed an interest in obtaining a Shoreline Use Permit (SUP) to use property owned and managed by Tacoma Power as part of its Cushman Hydroelectric Project. - 2. A top view (plan view) of structures and uses showing shape and outside dimensions of structure in feet.
- 3. A side view (elevation view) of structures and uses showing vertical elevation from the ordinary high water mark.
- 4. If structure is already built, please provide photographs of the structure and copies of any regulatory permits previously obtained.

5.	A description of construction methods and materials used (or to be used) for each structure. Attach a separate sheet of paper if necessary.
