

- Current c.1937 building is seismically deficient
- Shops facilities are undersized and lack proper adjacencies
- Warehouse space is inadequate and overflowing





Project Goals

Building Resiliency, Operational Effectiveness, and Future Growth

- Design and build new warehouse and shops facility to the appropriate seismic level
- Improve operations with appropriate spaces, better workflow and adjacencies
- · Accommodate anticipated growth

Master Plan Phase 1 New Warehouse & Shops	\$29,279,000
Master Plan Phase 2 Covered Storage, Renovate Ex. Bldg.	\$39,670,000
Total 20-Yr Build Out	\$68,949,000



Scope

- New seismically resilient warehouse and shops
 - Provide facility for essential staff and warehousing and shop functions for current and future needs

Schedule

- Select Design-Build Team Summer 2024
- Project Planning/Validation Fall 2024
- Design 2025/2026
- Construction 2026/2027

Total Project Budget

- \$30 Million
 - (\$22M \$25M Design & Construction)




Design-Build Team Selection

- Design-Build RFQ 6 Respondents
- Design-Build RFP Issued to 4 Finalists
- Selection Absher Construction (Contractor), DLR Group (Designer)
- Owner's Advisor Parametrix









Next Steps

Planning/Validation Commences

- Contract Approval: September Utility Board Meeting
- Planning/Validation: October 2024 February 2025
- Amend Contract: March 2025

Progressive Design-Build Part 1

- Begin Design: March 2025
- Negotiate Guaranteed Max Price: Q1 2026
- Amend Contract: Q1 2026

Progressive Design-Build Part 2

- Release Early Work Packages: 2026
- Construction: 2026/2027
