

Water rate adjustment in effect Jan.1

Residential customers can expect an average increase of about \$1 per month. Some major activities supported by rates include:

- Operating the Green River filtration facility
- Maintaining 24 wells to supplement water needs, mainly during summer demand
- Protecting thousands of acres in the Green River Watershed
- Upgrading and maintaining 1,376 miles of water main infrastructure

Providing clean drinking water is fundamental to community health. The rate adjustment will allow us to continue to invest in projects that keep you supplied with clean, reliable water every day. While we know any increase affects people, Tacoma Water customers enjoy some of the lowest rates in the Puget Sound region.

If you've been a customer for a year or more, you can sign up for Budget Billing. We average your last 12 months of bills so you can pay the same set amount each month to make it easier to budget and pay your utility bill.
